

General Formatting Guidelines: Abstracts must be submitted in Microsoft Word Document format (.docx or .doc) with a maximum of 500 words, written in 11 point Arial font and single spaced.

Abstract Title: The title must be brief and accurately reflect the content of the abstract. The title must be typed in bold face type and in title case.

Presenting Author: First and Last Name, Degree(s), Affiliation

Co-Authors: First and Last Name, Degree(s), Affiliation, repeat as needed

***Please note:** Abstracts can include a maximum of 5 authors, including the presenting author.*

Abstract Content: The abstract must be brief (no more than 500 words, single spaced), must reflect what is actually to be presented and be written in the English language. Jargon and undefined abbreviations should be avoided. All drugs are to be identified consistently in the abstract by generic names.

The following sections should be included in your abstract: Background, General Aim, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion and References. Comment with approval from the appropriate animal or human ethical review Board should be stated in the “Materials and “Methods” section of your abstract, if applicable.

Images: Only one table or figure can be included per abstract and must be incorporated in the Microsoft Word Document submitted. Images must be at least 300x300 pixels per inch in JPEG or TIF file format.

References: Number references in the order in which they appear in the abstract. The journal, volume and page number are required.
